Sparkling Wine

24. Robe d'Or Brut, France £14.95

A blanc de blancs sparkling wine. Good chilled as an apéritif or to liven up a party.

25. Casa Gheller Prosecco Frizzante Rosé, Italy £18.95

Lightly sparkling and fresh in style, this Prosecco is produced from the Roboso grape from selected vineyards on the Casa Gheller estate. The colour boasts a soft rose petal glow and the bouquet is flowery with hints of raspberries, cranberries and cherries that follow though on to the palate.

Champagne

26. Baron de Beaupre Non Vintage Champagne £37.50

Rounded fruity aromas lead onto a creamy palate with fresh acidity. Makes a great apéritif.

27. Veuve Clicquot Ponsardin, Yellow Label - Non Vintage Champagne £65.00

This Champagne has a yellow tinge and glow with a fine, steady bead. A soft, toasty nose and youthful palate, yet good fruit and balance, with a long fruity aftertaste.

Rosé Wine

23. Ca'Solare Pinot Grigio Rosé, Italy £16.50

Fresh, dry and crammed full of summer fruit flavours. A classic Italian wine with a twist of pink.

White Wines

1. Alto Pampas del Sur Viognier £14.95

Made from the Viognier grape which originates from the Rhone Valley in France, this white wine has banana and exotic fruit flavours. A very distinctive wine full of character

2. Peter Lehmann Weighbridge Chardonnay. Australia £17.50

A medium weight palate with delicious honey dew melon and peach characters and a clean fruit finish. A beautifully balanced and deliciously fragrant unwooded Chardonnay.

3. Peter Lehmann Barossa Valley Semillon £19.50

An unoaked, lively, zesty, refreshing and crisp Semillon with plenty of fruit flavour and great length.

4. Kendall Jackson Vintner's Reserve Chardonnay. California £29.00

Tropical flavours such as mango and pineapple dance with aromas of peach, apple and pear. Richly layered and balanced throughout. Lightly buttered toast headlines the indulgent, lingering finish

5. Vistamar Sauvignon Blanc. Chili £14.25

By glass 125ml - £3.75 250ml - £4.75

Pale greenish yellow in colour. Aromas of tropical fruit and white flowers are found on the nose. The palate is nicely balanced with a refreshing finish.

6. La Vedette Chardonnay France £15.25

By glass 125ml - £3.95 250ml - £5.10

A fine example of a Southern French Chardonnay. Full bodied, buttery and balanced with a tangy, citrus finish.

7. Muscadet de Sevre Et Maine Sur Lie Fief de la Brie, Loire £18.50

A superior example of this well known wine, light, dry and delicious with seafood.

8. Chablis Alain Bretin, Burgundy £29.95

Light in colour, yet full in body and weight. This elegant wine has good steely acidity, a typically young Chardonnay bouquet and a lasting finish.

9. Babich Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc. New Zealand £23.50

The aroma of wild herbs combines with tropical fruits and green apple. The palate is exuberant and intense - fruit salad, nettles and fresh herbs burst into existence and continue through the length of the palate, joined at the end by lime/citrus and mineral notes.

10. Coastline Chenin Blanc, South Africa £14.95

By glass 125ml - £3.85 250ml - £4.95

This wine is full of ripe tropical and citrus fruit aromas and flavours. Well balanced with a fresh and crisp finish. Enjoy on its own or with seafood, fish, chicken, vegetarian and lightly spiced dishes.

Red Wines

11. Rowland's Brook Shiraz/Cabernet £14.50

By glass 125ml - £3.85 250ml - £4.95

A medium bodied wine, soft and elegant with typical Australian fruitiness.

12. Kendall Jackson Vintner's Reserve Zinfandel. California £29.95

Plum, raspberry and blackberry flavours are supported with solid tannins in this rustic Zinfandel. Sultry cedar and spice accents linger on this captivating, long finishing wine

13. Vistamar Merlot. Chile £14.25

By glass 125ml - £3.75 250ml - £4.75

This ruby red wine is bursting with aromas and flavours of black cherries and sweet peppers. Rounded on the palate with soft, sweet tannins

14. Cousino Macul Antiguas Reserva Cabernet Sauvignon £25.50

Rich, concentrated Cabernet with layer upon layer of ripe cassis fruit perfectly complemented by soft tannins and a lovely, lingering finish.

15. La Vedette Shiraz. France £15.25

By glass 125ml - £3.95 250ml - £5.10

This southern French Shiraz was specially selected for its spicy fruit and depth of body.

16. Chateau Malbat, Bordeaux £19.95

The soft fruitiness of the Merlot grape is predominant in this excellent value claret, well balanced with a fresh, clean finish.

17. Chateau du Grand Moulas Cotes du Rhone £20.50

A wine full of character, ripe red berry aromas with a hint of pepper and liquorice on the palate

18. Chateaneuf du Pape Domaine du Remparts, Rhone £42.95

A rich, warm and fruity red from the Southern Rhone, excellent with hearty red meat dishes and cheese.

19. Chianti Cantine di Leonardo. Italy £20.95

Clear ruby red in colour with reasonable depth and 'legs' indicating good structure.

Perfumes of cherries and fresh red fruit mingle with spicy peppery notes.

20. Babich East Coast Pinot Noir. New Zealand £24.50

The bouquet is lifted with the aroma of strawberries and raspberries mingled with spice. The supple palate is of medium weight and has a sweet red fruited entry with spice showing its hand again. Earthy notes add a touch of complexity to the mid palate.

21. Freedom Cross Pinotage. South Africa £16.95

Medium to full bodied dry red wine with an approachable earthy and berry fruit aroma. Softly styled in character.

22. Rioja Vega Crianza. Spain £20.50

A traditional barrel aged Rioja, smooth, rich, complex and full of fruit.
